MINUTES REVIEWED

BILLS/RECEIPTS

OLD BUSINESS

The April 6th meeting will have a time change to 6:00pm so council can meet regarding ordinance development with representatives from Avolio Law Group.

The bids for the 2026 grass cutting season were opened. Lawn Sharks was the only contractor that submitted a bid for 2026. The bid submitted was for \$425.00 per cut during the duration of the season. Dave Rupert made a motion to accept the bid as presented. The motion was seconded by Clint Jacobs. Kathy Sikora and Mark Sikora abstained from the vote. The vote passed unanimously with the remaining council.

Brief discussion was held regarding culvert maintenance within the borough. Most of the culverts in town are mostly free of debris so cleaning would be held to a minimum.

NEW BUSINESS

Todd Heasley, Stanley Armstrong, and Mark Sikora researched building a new pavilion. They visited several existing other pavilions in area municipalities. They felt that a size of at least 25x40 feet would be required. Pricing information will be researched next. Pricing will be for both construction of a new pavilion and demolition of old one.
